What do SB5 & Cleveland Education Plan Have In Common?

Cleveland Mayor Frank Jackson spent weeks/months creating a new "plan" for Cleveland schools with business leaders - but left teachers out of the conversation until recently. Once teachers were invited in, the mayor essentially gave them his plan and said this is what we're going to do.

Teachers should have been permitted to have a voice in the development of this plan since they see what is needed in their classrooms and have lots of great ideas for improving student achievement. But they were not allowed to have a voice in the process. We are very concerned that this approach resembles elements of SB 5.

Much like what Governor Kasich and his radical friends wanted to do with Senate Bill 5, the first objective in this plan is to eliminate collective bargaining rights. **Read more about it here and take the poll. Again, this plan is nothing more than Senate Bill 5 in disguise.**
